Meeting Notes 12/2/2015

Reflecting discussions started at the 10/7/15 District meeting of possible reimbursement to DCM for travel expenses [mileage & tolls] for DCM's participation in Area 48 AA service events - since DCM is expected, as part of DCM's AA service responsibilities, to participate in Area 48 AA service events and report back to District and Groups - and as further discussed at the 11/4/15 District meeting - and as reported in the District's November Newsletter that action might be taken at the 12/2/15. District meeting, motion was made, seconded and approved unanimously at 12/2 District meeting to make DCM mileage & toll expenses for participation in Area 48 and related AA service activities eligible for reimbursement [but not for Conventions and not for meals, lodging, etc.]. The subject of possible lodging reimbursement for DCM participation at broader AA service sessions, i.e. NERAASA, will be discussed at the next 1/6/16 District meeting;

Peter R. reported on fact that the Adirondack Cluster of Area 48 Districts [Districts 5, 10, 13 and 19] will be hosting the **Year 2016 Annual Area 48 Convention** to be held in our geographic area for the first time in many years. Peter is co-chair of the 2016 Convention Committee which the District voted unanimously on 12/2 to make a regular District 13 Committee until after that 2016 Convention. More information on Convention planning will be available at the 1/6/16 District meeting.
